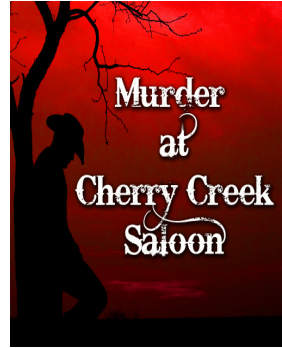


The Suspects



Delilah Hays

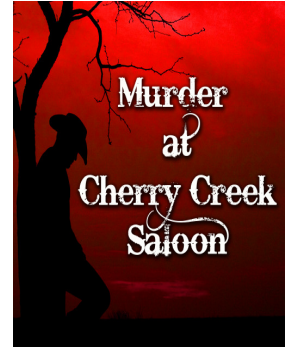

Kitty Flores

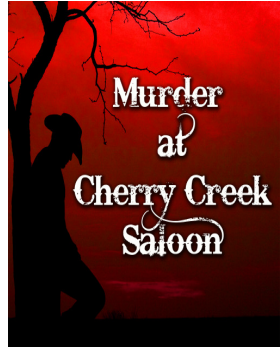

Mollie Masterson

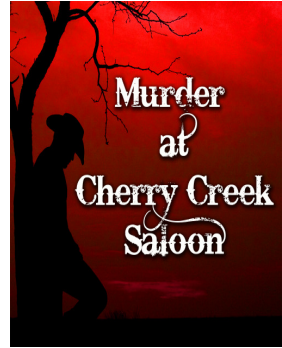

Helga Barnes

Helga Barnes is the cards dealer at the Cherry Creek Saloon, and has been for years. Each night without fail, Helga takes a seat at the table and waits for players. Some nights she has a full table, other nights she spends alone. Helga is an all around angry person. To Helga, a stranger is just someone she doesn't hate yet. She has a low tolerance for hi-jinks at her cards table, and even less tolerance for cheating. Helga treats everyone she meets equally – with unbridled contempt, and does it in a conservative western dress.



Cassie Flores

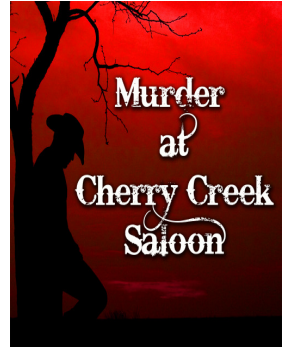

Tupper Farley

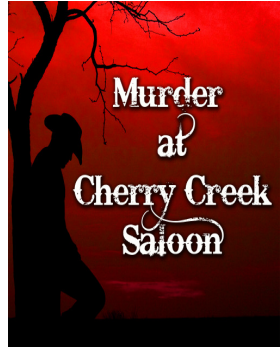
